<u>Standard Violated</u>	<u>Description</u>
1926.652(a)(1)	Employees in excavation not adequately protected from cave-ins
5(a)(1)	General Duty Clause
1926.501(b)(1)	Inadequate or no fall protection while on walking surfaces $\geq$ 6'
1904.39(a)(2)	Employer did not report an in-patient hospitalization, amputation, or loss of an eye within 24 hours.
1926.21(b)(2)	The employer did not instruct each employee in the recognition and avoidance of unsafe conditions and the regulations applicable to their work environment to control or eliminate any hazards.
1926.1153(d)(2)(i)	The employer did not assess the exposure of each employee who was or may have been reasonably expected to be exposed to respirable crystalline silica at or above the action level.
1926.200(g)(2)	Traffic control signs and devices use for protection of construction workers did not conform to MUTCD
1910.1200(e)(1)	No written hazard communication program
1926.106(c)	When employees were working over or near water, ring buoys with at least 90 feet of line were not provided for emergency rescue operations.
1926.1153(c)(1)	For each employee engaged in a task identified in Table 1, the employer did not fully and properly implement the engineering controls, work practices and respirator protections specified for the task in Table 1.
1910.1200(h)	No hazard communication training

- 1910.134(e)(1) Employer did not provide a medical evaluation to determine the employees ability to use a respirator.
- 1926.106(d) No lifesaving skiff immediately available at locations where employees are working over of adjacent to water.
- 1926.251(a)(1) Rigging equipment was not inspected prior to use and as necessary during use (Defective rigging equipment was not removed from service)
- 1926.453(b)(2)(iv) Employees did not always stand firmly on the floor of the basket of an aerial lift.
