On Thursday, March 11, 2021, the Associated General Contractors of America released new data showing the impacts of the coronavirus on the construction sector one year into the pandemic. The new data is based on a survey of construction firms and includes details on how the coronavirus is impacting demand for construction, the cost and availability of key construction materials, hiring plans and job site safety.
