## **Bipartisan Infrastructure Bill Appears on Track to Pass the Senate**

A roughly \$1 trillion bipartisan infrastructure bill cleared a critical hurdle in the Senate on Saturday, paving the way for final Senate consideration. The vote was 67-27. It is unclear when a final vote would occur.



The legislation includes nearly \$550 billion in new spending above what Congress was already planning to allocate for infrastructure over the next eight years. If passed in the Senate, the bill faces an uncertain future in the House where a number of progressive Democrats are frustrated with the limited scope of the bill.

The bipartisan infrastructure bill represents the best chance to significantly invest in building and maintaining a broad range of physical infrastructure without unnecessarily burdening the construction industry with new taxes and workforce mandates.
