3-Part AGC Webinar Series: Preparing for the OSHA COVID-19 Vaccine/Testing Mandate

Part 1: Monday, Nov. 8, 3:30 PM - OSHA COVID-19 Vaccine/Testing Mandate: Leveraging Outside Solutions to Meet the Mandate

OSHA will soon issue an emergency temporary standard to require employers with 100 or more employees to ensure their workers are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or tested for infection on at least a weekly basis.

- What are some of the basic requirements of this new mandate?

- How may AGC of America look to challenge this mandate?

The legal and contractually implications from this new legal requirement will be significant, swift and complex. What should companies contemplate to comply with this new law? Also, which practical and legal ramifications will stem from this change that will impact your work?
