## **Trenching & Excavation Hazards in Construction Safety Training**

AGC of America, supported by a Susan Harwood Federal Training Grant, is pleased to offer a one-day Trenching & Excavation Hazards in Construction safety training. Attendees will earn a digital certificate and continuing education credits (0.8 IACET CEUs).

The course will review OSHA Subpart P excavation standards and best practices. Recent statistics from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) indicate an average of 25 excavations deaths per year have occurred from 2015 to 2018.

- Injury, Illness, and fatality statistics and frequently cited standards
- Common hazards, protective systems, and utilities protection
- Soil testing and classification
- Review of OSHA initiatives and much more...
