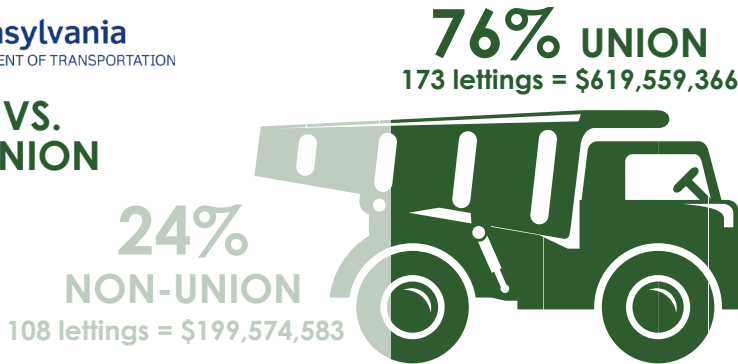

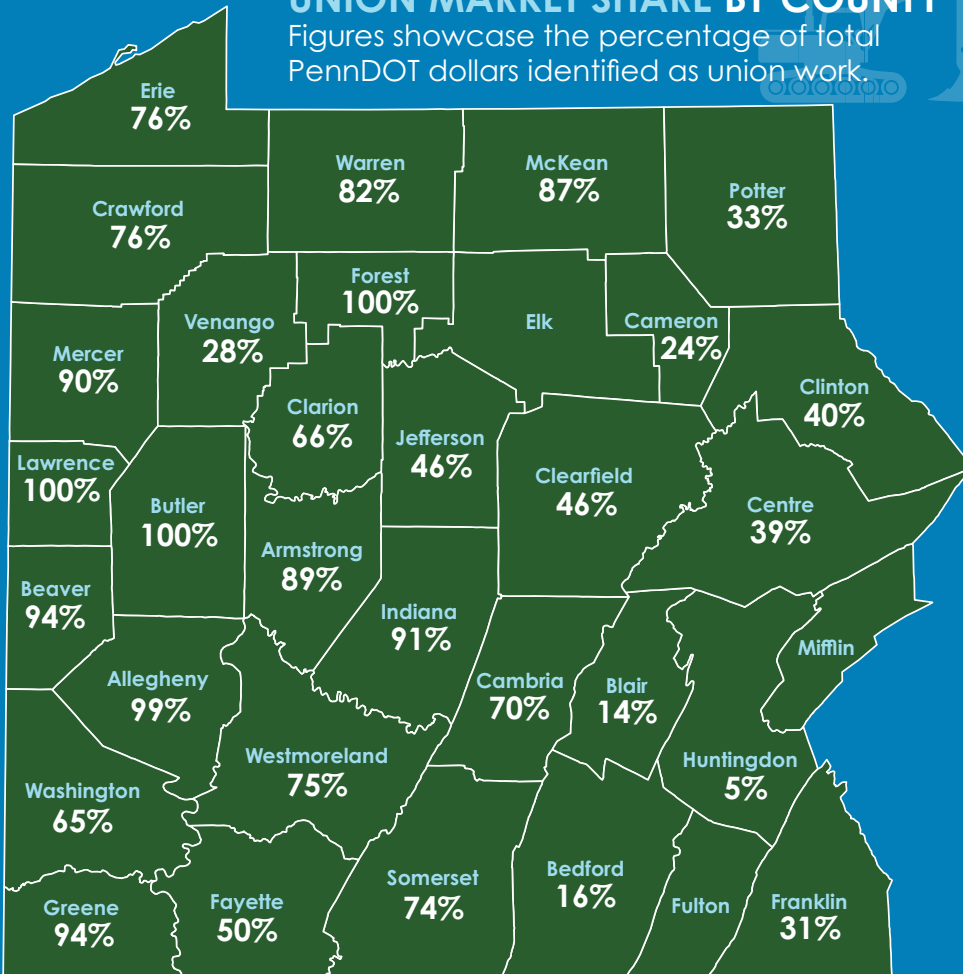
UNION VS. NON-UNION WORK
