CAWP Reaches Deal for New Four-Year Labor Agreement

The Constructors Association of Western Pennsylvania Labor Committee has reached an agreement on a four-year heavy and highway labor agreement for the years 2023 through 2026 with the Carpenters and Pile Drivers Local #274, Cement Masons Local #526, Laborers District Council of Western Pennsylvania, Operating Engineers Local #66 and Teamsters Joint Council #40. The changes in contract terms will be provided soon.

The Unions are in the process of determining the allocations of the increases in wages and benefits, and it is estimated that these should be completed and shared with CAWP contractor members in mid-January.

Contractors bidding on prevailing wage projects in the immediate future are to bid using the 2022 wage rates until the 2023 wage rates appear in the project specifications.

In the meantime, the financial terms of the settlement are as follows:



Safety Awards Programs – Get Recognized for Your Company's Safety Achievements

Plan to submit your company's safety statistics for both the CAWP/H2AP Safety Awards and the AGC NASA Safety Awards programs in January. The entry forms were combined so that you submit only one form. Most of the information comes from your company's 2022 OSHA Form 300A.

CAWP/H2AP Safety Awards Program

The CAWP/H2AP Safety Awards program recognizes companies for their safe work performance in western Pennsylvania during the 2022 season. The award is an opportunity to receive well-deserved recognition from your peers in the industry. Awards are based on each company's Lost Workday Incidence Rate. Awards will be presented at the annual CAWP/H2AP Safety Banquet on March 31, 2023.

Note: The CAWP/H2AP Safety Award represents heavy, highway, railroad and utility work performed within the 33 counties of western Pennsylvania.

National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) Program

The AGC of America's National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) program provides AGC members an opportunity to evaluate their safety record. Participating contractors receive a confidential printout to compare their company's safety statistics with similar size and type AGC contactor members both locally and nationally. Safety awards are given to members who have a zero-incident rate or who have an incident rate 25 percent below each occupational division's average. Awards will be delivered in the spring of 2023.

Note: The AGC NASA program is for AGC/CAWP members only. If you are unsure of your membership status, submit the electronic form and CAWP will determine eligibility.
