CAWP is offering Confined Space Entry - Competent Person training to prepare individuals to assume the role of Competent Person under OSHA's 1926 Subpart AA Standard (confined spaces). Specifically, attendees will learn the following:

- How to evaluate each project/jobsite for the presence of confined spaces.
- How to identify each space that is a confined space through consideration and evaluation of the elements of that space, including testing if necessary.
- How to identify existing and predictable hazards in the surroundings or working conditions which are unsanitary, hazardous, or dangerous.
- When and how to take prompt corrective measures to correct potentially dangerous working conditions.
- What are needed duties and responsibilities for reclassifying a "Permit Space" to a "Non-Permit Required Space."

In addition, attendees will obtain a working knowledge of testing procedures and equipment to be used to ensure pre-entry conditions are met and become familiar with the physical characteristics, configuration, and location of confined spaces potentially at each project/jobsite.
