Building a Culture of RESPECT

CAWP to release New Type of Anti-Harassment Training called *RESPECT*

The purpose of this new program, RESPECT, is to educate company managers and supervisors on how to build a more respectful workplace environment through a series of educational content and videos. Instead of traditional compliance training that solely focuses on legal definitions and standards for liability, this program will focus on respect, acceptable workplace conduct, and the types of behaviors that contribute to a respectful workplace.

Course Topics:

- Overview of the new RESPECT program, its components, and how it will benefit your company.
- Learn why companies and supervisors should value a respectful workplace.
- Highlight the costs of disrespectful behavior, including incivility, bullying, and unlawful harassment to your company's bottom line.
- Review the skillsets needed by supervisors to intervene when they observe disrespectful or abusive behavior.
- How to train your supervisors to create a respectful workplace by using the *Respect* video series, which includes:
- A 30-minute video designed to assist supervisors in

responding effectively to employee concerns and reports of misconduct or disrespectful behavior.

- Four short (10-15 minute) videos on a variety of related topics, to be used as reinforcement of the overall message of the program.
- Handouts and other resources like toolbox talks, etc. for supervisors to refer to and use.
