A 30-minute video designed to assist supervisors in responding effectively to employee concerns and reports of misconduct or disrespectful behavior

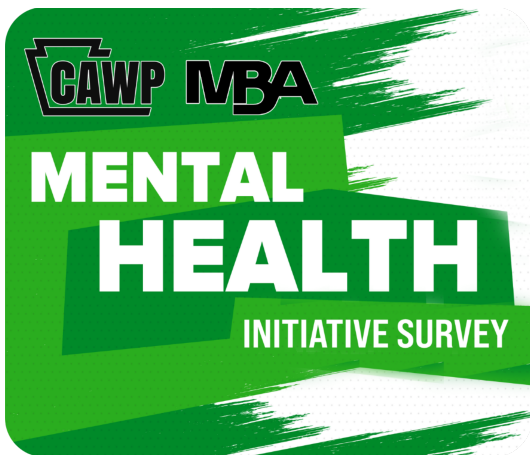
Four short (10-15 minute) videos on a variety of related topics, to be used as reinforcement of the overall message of the program

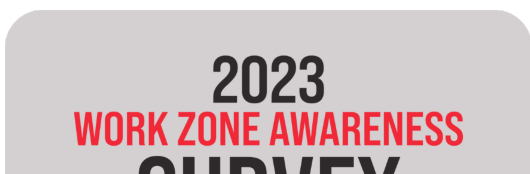
