This popular program teaches elementary school students to apply for a job, write checks, maintain a cash register, operate banks, manage a business, and vote for mayor, helping students connect the dots between what they learn in school and the real world.

Throughout the spring, volunteers staffed the Construction Storefront to assist student participants with pricing and selling tape measures, managing the store finances, and building a bench.
