Register Today: 24-hour Competent Person Fall Protection Training

CAWP is hosting a 24-hour competent person fall protection training that complies with EM 385-1-1 on August 7, 8 and 9. EM 385 training is mandatory for contractors who work on military and federally funded



contracts or projects, this does not include state and/or federally assisted contracts like PennDOT work. The EM 385-1-1 requires that Competent Persons for fall protection attend a 24-hour fall protection training class.

Note: this class is open to anyone in need of competent person fall protection training, regardless of if the EM 385 certificate is needed or not.

Attendees will learn about types of falls, and fall statistics, protection options (hierarchy of controls) OSHA, ANSI & EM 385 standards/regulations, ANSI/EM 385 compliant equipment & terminology, rescue from heights (self-rescue & assisted rescue), USACE-only permitted policies, practices, and requirements.

Date/Time: August 7, 8, 9 from 7:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.
