Learn, Share, and Solve HR and Workforce Challenges with the CAWP HR and Workforce Best Practices Program

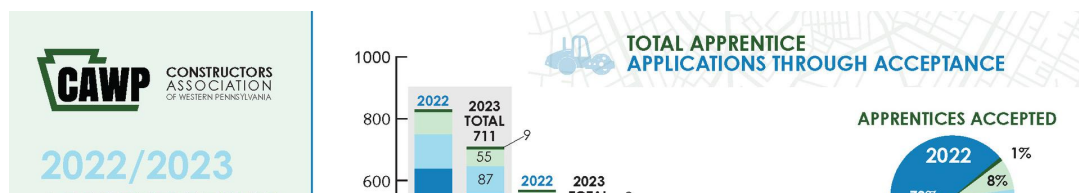

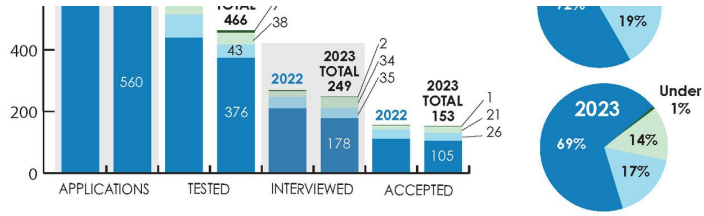
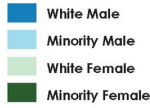

APPRENTICESHIP DATA COMPARISON

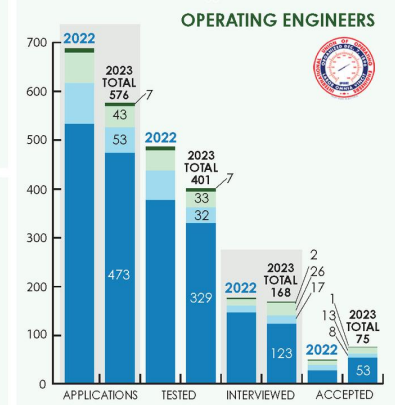


APPRENTICE DATA BY TYPE OF WORK
