New Training Partnership Announcement!

CAWP is excited to launch a new collaboration with the National Safety Council (NSC)!

Expanding Work Zone Safety Training for Contractors

CAWP has teamed up with the National Safety Council (NSC) to host two instructor development courses to our valued contractor members. The courses will be held at CAWP's offices on January 17-19.

The benefits of the partnership will allow contractors to train their crews on work zone courses at a much lower costs than other providers and on a convenient, as-needed basis.

WORK ZONE TECHNICIAN – Instructor Development Course

January 17, 2024 – 8:00 am – 4:30 pm

Course Description – 8-hour course; participants must complete a 1.5hour e-learning course before January 17. Each participant receives an interactive tabletop set. Participants are to have a minimum of two years of practical work zone experience, and/or experience teaching a work zone program or similar safety and/or regulatory program. Participants should also have prior flagger and technician card/certificate or pass courses.

WORK ZONE SUPERVISOR – Instructor Development Course

January 18-19, 2024 – 8:00 am – 4:30 pm

Course Description – 16-hour course; same experience as Workzone Technician Course but experience can include design, deployment/removal, monitoring and maintenance. Resume is required.

Instructor: Michael Ezzell, Master Instructor, National Safety Council

Deadline to register is January 5, 2024.

Costs:

Work Zone Technician (IDC) - \$1,500

Work Zone Supervisor (IDC) - \$200

Fee includes all materials. Fee reduced by 25% for CAWP/H2AP members; non-member pricing available – call CAWP. Note: NSC charges a \$65 annual recertification for instructors.

Safety Awards Programs – Get **Recognized for Your Company's Safety Achievements**



Plan to submit your company's safety statistics for both the

CAWP/H2AP Safety Awards and the AGC NASA Safety Awards programs in January. The entry forms were combined so that you submit only one form. Most of the information comes from your company's 2022 OSHA Form 300A.

CAWP/H2AP Safety Awards Program

The CAWP/H2AP Safety Awards program recognizes companies for their safe work performance in western Pennsylvania during the 2023 season. The award is an opportunity to receive well-deserved recognition from your peers in the industry. Awards are based on each company's Lost Workday Incidence Rate. Awards will be presented at the annual CAWP/H2AP Safety Banquet on March 15, 2024.

Note: The CAWP/H2AP Safety Award represents heavy, highway, railroad and utility work performed within the 33 counties of western Pennsylvania.

National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) Program

The AGC of America's National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) program provides AGC members an opportunity to evaluate their safety record. Participating contractors receive a confidential printout to compare their company's safety statistics with similar size and type AGC contactor members both locally and nationally. Safety awards are given to members who have a zero-incident rate or who have an incident rate 25 percent below each occupational division's average. Awards will be delivered in the spring of 2024.

Note: The AGC NASA program is for AGC/CAWP members only. If you are unsure of your membership status, submit the electronic form and CAWP will determine eligibility.
