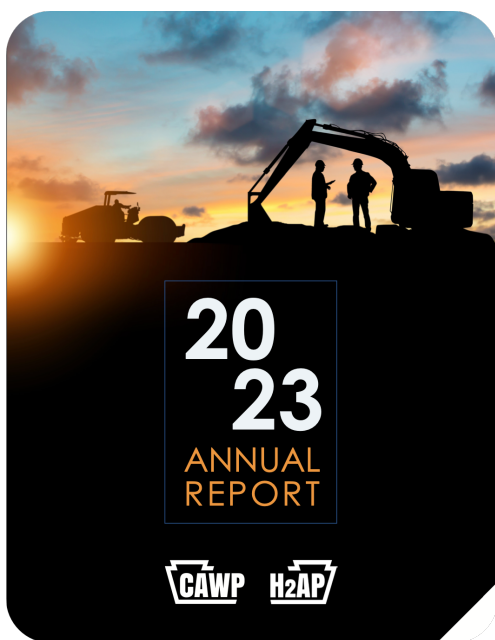

groundbreaking engineering concepts, influencing iconic structures like the Brooklyn and Golden Gate Bridges.
