Changes to Laborers' Benefit Allocations for 2025-2026

The Pennsylvania Laborers' District Council recently notified the Association of changes their membership has approved regarding the reallocation of pension and welfare benefit rates for 2025 and 2026. Please note that these changes involve a reallocation of monies from the Medical to the Pension Fund, and do not increase, decrease, or change the total wage and fringe benefit amounts.

2025 - Standard Agreement and Addendum #1

- Reallocated money from the Medical (Welfare) Fund to the Pension Fund

Medical	12.79
Pension	13.89
Training	0.25
Health & Safety	0.07
Total	\$61.70
