House Panel OKs Bill to Speed Up PSP Transfer

A House committee approved a bipartisan bill last week to speed up the transfer of public funding for the Pennsylvania State Police to the taxpayer-supported General Fund from the Motor License Fund, which supports work on roads and bridges.

The Transportation Committee voted unanimously in favor of House Bill 1085 to remove the state police altogether as a recipient of Motor License revenue by Fiscal

Year 2026-27. Under HB1085, the state police would receive one final transfer of \$125 million from the Motor License Fund in FY 2025-26.


Removing the state police from the Motor License Fund has been a policy goal for years as the need increases for more revenue to fix roads and bridges.
