Carpenter and Pile Driver Fringe Benefit Allocation Changes

The Carpenters and Pile Drivers have notified the Association of changes they are making to the allocation of their fringe benefits for 2025 and 2026. The changes are as follows:

- **Carpenters and Pile Drivers:** 2025 and 2026, Standard Agreement and Addendum #1 Wages – reallocated \$0.32 from Savings to Medical
- **Carpenters:** 2025 and 2026, Addendum #2 Wages – reallocated \$1.13 from Pension and \$1.13 from Savings to Medical, thereby increasing the Medical by \$2.26.
- **Pile Drivers:** 2025 and 2026, Addendum #2 Wages – reallocated \$1.32 from the Pension to Medical.

These changes will become effective when contractors begin paying the 2025 and 2026 wage rates. If you are already paying the 2025 wage rates, please make this change at your earliest convenience.
