Protect the People Building America's Roads

If you build our nation's highways, you've seen it firsthand— drivers flying through your work zones like a racetrack. AGC just ran a survey, and the numbers back up what we all know: 60% of highway contractors had crashes in their work zones this past year, and nearly everyone—98%—says it's just as bad or worse than it was a year ago.

Federal agencies and Congress talk a lot about keeping drivers and pedestrians safe, but what about the people actually building our highways?

Take 30 seconds to speak up: Send a quick pre-written message to U.S. Transportation Secretary Sean Duffy and your members of Congress asking them to:

- 1. Require states to dedicate funding specifically for work zone safety when they see increases in crashes and fatalities.
- 2. Make sure work zone awareness is part of driver's ed and distracted driving courses.
- 3. Incentivize state DOTs to utilize automated traffic enforcement systems, or speed cameras, in highway work zones

You can also add a personal note to the message if you've had close calls or crashes on your sites.

Crews deserve to go home safe at the end of the day. Let Secretary Duffy and Congress know it's time to take work zone safety seriously—and stop leaving it all on contractors' shoulders.

Prevent a Massive Tax Increase for Construction

Without action from Congress and the White House, most construction companies will face a 20% tax increase in 2026 as key provisions of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) are set to expire.

Take Action in 30 Seconds: Send a prewritten message to your U.S. senators and representative urging them to:

- 1. Protect small construction companies by making the 199A/Qualified Business Income Deduction permanent to prevent a 20% tax hike.
- 2. Increase the estate tax exemption to help family-owned construction companies.
- 3. Restore full expensing for new and used construction equipment purchases.

You can also personalize your message to highlight how this issue impacts your business and employees.

Without action, your business will pay more in taxes, have fewer resources to invest, and struggle to stay competitive.
