CAWP President Ali Mills and CAWP Executive Director Rich Barcaskey attended an event at the White House to support the One, Big, Beautiful Bill.



AGC of America extended the invitation to the event to discuss provisions in the bill that would extend the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act. If the bill is not passed, changes to the "individual" sections of the tax code, the estate tax exemption, and the reduction in individual rates will expire at the end of 2025. If Congress fails to act before then, pass-through businesses, on average, will face a 20 percent tax

AGC developed a <u>one-page summary</u> on the importance of extending the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act.

Webinars are offered on a variety of E-Verify and Form I-9 topics including Overview, Federal Contractor, acceptable documents for Form I-9, and more. On-Demand webinars are also available and offer the convenience of selecting the chapters you need or watching the entire webinar.

All webinars are eligible for professional development credits (PDCs) through the Society of Human Resource Management (SHRM) and the Human Resource Certification Institute (HRCI) except for *E-Verify in 30* and *myE-Verify*.
