## FHWA 1391 REPORT SUBMISSION 2025 INSTRUCTIONS

### **2025 Instructions for FHWA 1391 Report Submissions for Prime & Subcontractors**

All contractors (prime and subs) awarded Federal-Aid Highway construction contracts in Pennsylvania of \$10,000 or more, are required to submit the Federal-Aid Highway Construction Contractors Annual FHWA-1391 Report. Data must reflect the workforce on the project during the latest pay period

worked in July 2025. For clarification, any contractor who performed work during the month of July must submit a report.

Submitting the FHWA 1391 report is web-based. Please note that there is a new URL for the FHWA 1391 Report site. **All PennDOT Business Partners will submit the report online [here](#).**

Your company's Engineering and Construction Management System (ECMS) login and password will be required to access the reporting site to complete and submit the report.

Contractors must submit a report for all projects listed under "Open projects" on the Business Partner home screen. If no work was conducted on the project during the month of July 2025, simply select the project, scroll down to the bottom of the page, and click on "Submit Annual FHWA Report".

Print a copy of your report for your files in case the system malfunctions and your report is not received by PennDOT. This will keep your company from receiving an out of compliance notification and provide you with a record of your submission.
