The Robert Miner Family Foundation, established in 2023 by Bob Miner Jr., former owner of Donegal Construction and past President of the CAWP Board of Governors, and his wife, recently donated \$500,000 to Westmoreland County Community College to

support students in skilled trades and allied healthcare. The donation will be awarded over the next five years, \$100,000 each year, to support those who would otherwise be unable to complete their degree or incur debt to do so.

Informational exhibitors on-site will include the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention and Veterans Affairs.

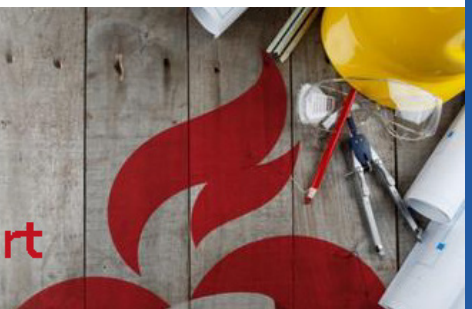
