# CAWP Constructing Connections Webinar Series - Federal Highway Reauthorization – April 29



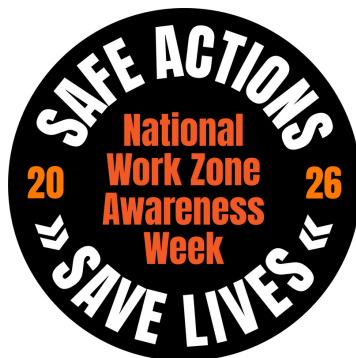
