In comparison to overall American workers, construction workers have a significantly higher rate of injuries, overdose deaths, fatalities, and deaths by suicide.

According to a recent Centers for Disease Control and Prevention report, construction workers died of a drug overdose at three times the rate of the average worker, and in 2021, the Center for Construction Research and Training (CPWR) states that almost one-fifth (17.9%) of deaths by suicide where the occupational industry was reported were in construction.

To help improve overall worker well-being and prevent opioid overdoses and suicides, CPWR has developed free, practical tools, including toolbox talks, hazard alerts, infographics, and training programs.
